MHA is currently seeking full-time, part-time, or locum Internal Medicine physicians to provide care to inpatients (up to 4 ICU patients and 10-15 medical patients), as well as providing consult service to our Family Practice Hospitalist teams. Our hospital offers:

- A wide range of diagnostic services, including Laboratory, MRI, CT, US, Cardiac Investigations (ECG, ECHO, Holter, Stress Testing), and Pulmonary Function Tests
- Excellent in-house specialist support including General Surgery, Orthopedics, Ophthalmology, ENT, and Plastics. Urology also available off-site. Access to tertiary level subspecialty support is available at nearby London Health Sciences Centre.

- Experience and comfort managing Level 2 and 3 ICU patients, including mechanical ventilation & ventilator settings, and providing pharmacologic inotropic/vasopressor support
- Experience and comfort with various procedures, including endotracheal intubation, central line placement, thoracentesis/paracentesis, electrical cardioversion/pacing
- Canadian citizenship or permanent residency
- Strong interpersonal and collaborative skills
- Full vaccination against COVID-19

Inpatient service coverage comprises 1 week blocks with weekday coverage (Mon-Thurs) from 7am to 5pm and 24/7 coverage from Friday to Sunday. Call requirements for off-service weeks are 1-2 weeknights/week. Remuneration is fee-for-service billings and HOCC funding for evening/weekend call. Additional income opportunities are also available such as ECG/Holter and PFT interpretation, cardiac stress tests, and outpatient clinics (i.e., pre-op and urgent medicine clinics).
